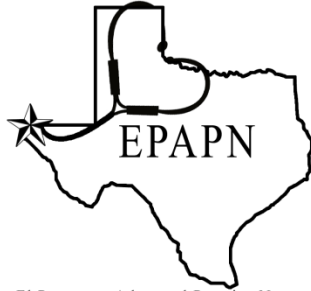
- a. Record minutes of EPAPN membership and executive committee meetings;
